A. Shift of ACAMS from Door 1801 will impact approx 20 other doors. Coordination with APD under way.

11/1/2018

A. Area 3 (work on curb outside of vendor roll-down door) expected to be completed in Dec.

10/18/2018

A. Area 3 facing challenges with vault/manhole connection to ductbank. Possible VSR impact and impact to trash area.

10/4/2018

A. Ops raised a concern regarding concrete trucks backing into taxilane. And that flaggers are more aware of aicraft pushback.

7/12/2018

A. Area 3 for DWP vault has a construction duration of approximately 3 months.

B. The 2 recieving pits on the CTA curb needs to be enlarged. Workplan being developed.

6/14/2018

A. Eve McEneaney (Terminal Ops) coducted walk with Fire Department who have made requests of the project related to maintaining muster area, etc.

B. Issues still exists related to Delta Airline jetblast. Cary Buchanan (Ops) has agreed that blacking out 1st stop may be needed.

A. Gateway Inbound 10A will close temporarily on Oct 1.

A. Exterior barricade plan at the inbound BHS area is being evaluated for effectiveness.

A. Interior barricade inside Bradley expected to be in place within next 2 weeks.

A. Terrazzo mock-up at the north end of the concourse has started.

9/20/2018

A. Ops asked if reflective tape could be added to airfield signs that have been decommissioned for TWY D Fuel Line work.

8/9/2018

A. Sanitary Sewer Pit 4 work expected to begin in Sep.

7/12/2018

- A. Upon review of bypass by LADBS, a new procedure is required and being vetted.
- B. Fuel Line tie-in impacting TWY D expected to start Sep 17. NOCC to be submitted to APD by Jul 17th.

5/31/2018

- A. Cary Buchanan (Ops) stated that TWY 'D' needs to be open and back in service by mid-May 2019.
- B. Airport Police noticed some gaps in the fencing on the MSC site. They asked that the MSC team secure the fencing. APD also mentioned that perhaps parking decals would help identify who is authorized to be parked on site. Also, in case of vandalism, employees can call APD to report.

5/3/2018

A. Ops has asked that as pavement gets completed at the north end of MSC, it gets turned over for use.

4/19/2018

A. Cary Buchanan (Ops) prefers that the Fuel Line Tie-in on the north side of the concourse that will impact TWY D to start after Sep 15.

B. MSC team reported that the RON north of Taxilane T would not be available for use after May 14, 2018, Cary Buchanan (Ops) asked the MSC team to prolong use of the RON as long as possible.

3/22/2018

A. MSC crane is scheduled to be back on-site April 9th, 2018. But will likely push back to April 16th, 2018.

1/11/2018

A. Airport Operations stated that the start of Fuel line tie-in work should be done in conjunction with any work needed on the north end of MSC so that Taxiway D closure occurs only once for MSC work.

Tunnels

010-001 7/11/2019

A. Tunnels (Crossover) For Firewater shutdown, water truck will be on stand by in the case it is needed for stand pipes.

6/27/19

A. Tunnels (Crossover) Gate 141, Southwest Airlines Offices sewage spill clean-up and restoration in progress. The flood was due to pump failure.

6/13/2019

A. MSC Team advised the group regarding the AOA security wall at the MSC basement-end of the Passenger Tunnel. This is an ACAM security barricade and not meant for personnel traffic.

B. Passenger Tunnel to be accessed from airside.

5/2/2019

A. Kelley Larson (TBITEC) asked that the activation of the jetbridges at 132 be coordinated with TBITEC because maintenance work needs to be performed. Steve Lawrence on the MSC team will coordinate.

4/18/2019

A. MSC team will conduct a walk with Maintenance when lift station is installed at 132 area.

4/4/2019

A. MSC reviewing Ops comments regarding aircraft movement for 132 and 134 areas. This includes hold-bars, wing tip clearances, blast fence.

3/21/2019

A. Aircraft push-back at Gate 134 issues. Aircraft wings coming into job site. Ops will meet with GSE providers to address.

B. Natural Gas shutdown on Mar 29th dependent on Sempra Mar 25th install of new gas meter.

2/7/2019

A. Aircraft Movement for 132 reopening (currently planned for Jul) and closure of 134 with Ops upcoming.

11/29/2018

 A. Gate 134 PBBs will remain intact and stowed when Gate 134 Closes.

11/15/2018

A. Nightly implact to Gate 134 for access required. Likely to start end of Dec. Durations TBD.

<u>Tunnels</u>

9/6/2018

A. MMRP waiver for dirt hauling is in effect through end of Sep.

7/12/2018

A. Passenger Tunnel 12-hour gas shutdown being reviewed and MSC is trying to improve on the duration.

6/28/2018

- A. MMRP waver will be submitted for concrete pours at tunnels.
- B. Fire Water will be approx 2 month duration. Water will be available but no redundancy.
- C. Domestic Water will be nightly shut downs only.

5/31/2018

A. Security wall/door has been activated. The teams should communicate to others that no one is to use these doors. In the case where the alarm is set off, TPJV to collect names of individuals.

3/22/2018

A. MSC team stated that there will be some intermittent impact to Gate 130 and 134. Dates are being coordinated with Airport Operations (Brandon Tseng). Rodney Thompson (Airport Operations) mentioned that Aircraft Service International Group (ASIG) will also be doing fuel work and require shut-downs in mid-April 2018. MSC team and Airport Operations will coordinate.

2/8/2018

A. Utilidor/Crossover hauling expected to end at the end of March 2018.

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
